This money will be used for purchasing materials for experiences in 3D Art, primarily ceramics and glass but also some fabric dyeing, printing and some wood art. All three art classes will benefit from the funds. Students will experience working with 3D materials so that they will increase their understanding of how to achieve design elements in 3D form. They will also learn how to manipulate these materials and solve technical problems as they arise in the art process. These experiences are aligned with Oregon Visual Art Standards Anchor Standard 1: Creating-Generate and conceptualize artistic ideas and work. Enduring Understanding: Creative ideas develop out of life experiences and are explored utilizing inquiry methods including observation, research and experimentation. Creativity and innovative thinking are essential life skills that can be developed. Artists and designers shape artistic investigations, following or breaking established conventions, in pursuit of creative art making goals. Specifically per grade: 8th grade "Individually and/or collaboratively design an object or art work that is based on a need, theme, or aesthetics that demonstrates developing technical skill". And, 6th and 7th grade, "Persist through and learn from challenging artistic investigations throughout the art-making process to develop technical skills."
